of these old sayings and wives' tales. Some are good for a laugh and others are remarkably accurate. Temperature dependent events have been tracked for centuries, long before devices were invented to measure actual temperatures. These

Blooming dogwood tree. events were recorded and passed down through many generations. The study of recurring bio-

logical events and their relationship to weather is called Phenology. Bird migration and flowers blooming are examples of phonological events. This is the time of year when I get asked when is the grass going to green up or when will you start mowing everyday? In this day and age, we have research and studies to supply us with answers to these questions. Studies on turfgrass in Alabama tells us that Bermuda grass breaks winter dormancy and greens up when nighttime temperatures are a consistent 50 degrees. New growth occurs when night temps hit 60 degrees, and aggressive, full blown summer growth happens when nighttime lows and highs add up to 150 degrees. Many thousand, if not millions, of dollars have probably been spent to supply a scientific answer when "just wait until the dogwoods bloom" would have been sufficient.
